

Color Approval in InSite Smart Review

Quick Reference Card

Getting Started

To approve color, follow these steps:

1. In the Kodak® InSite™ Prepress Portal software, in Smart Review, open the color-managed page.
2. Review the page in Full Screen Preview.
3. Approve or reject the page for color.

Requirements

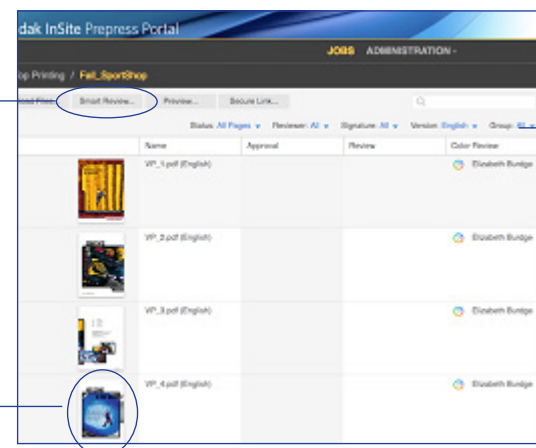
- Mac Pro or Mac Mini (see Release Notes for supported OS versions)
 - Safari browser (ONLY)
 - A calibrated monitor
 - A Prepress Portal job role that has a Color Management user right
 - A dimmable viewing booth (if comparing virtual proof with hard copy)
- * Set the Smart Review preference for **Screen PPI** to correct value (for more information, see the online help).

Open a Color-Managed Page in Smart Review

1. Open the job and click the **Pages** tab to view all pages.
2. Click **Smart Review**, or click a thumbnail image of the page.

To open the first page of a job, click **Smart Review**.

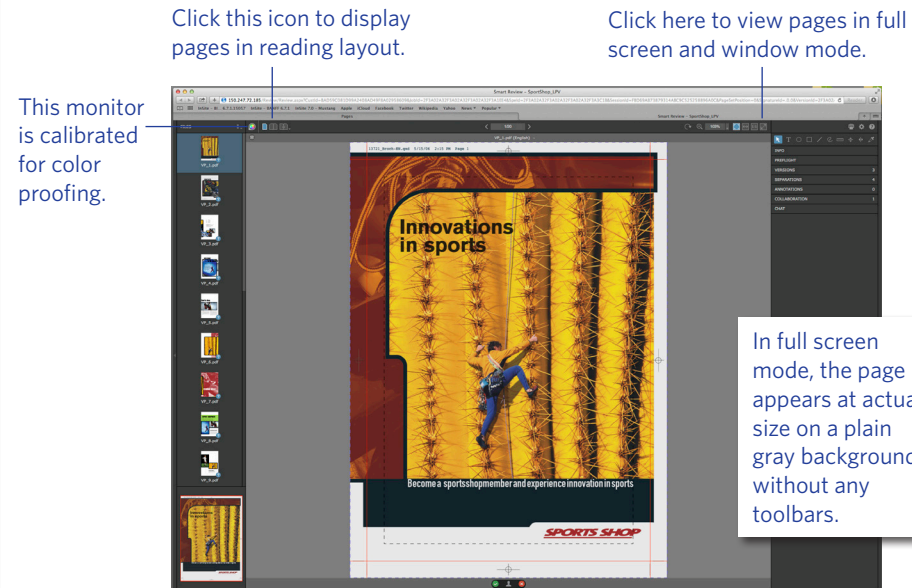
To open a specific page, click the thumbnail.



Filter the pages or select a page group

Review the Page

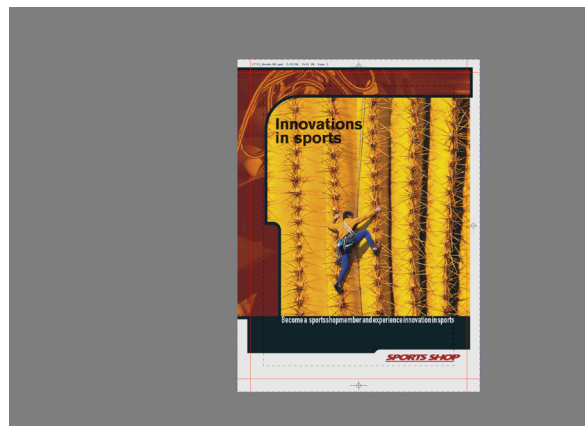
1. Open the page in actual size.



2. Review color.

View the page on the monitor.

Allow at least 10 minutes for light tubes in a viewing booth to warm up before viewing a proof. If the lamps are new, run them for 24 hours to allow them to stabilize.

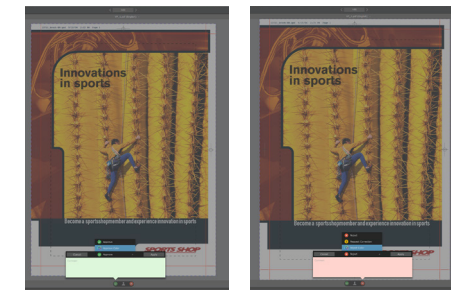
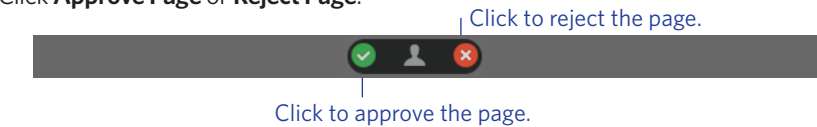


If the page does not fit on the monitor, click the page. Then, move the page to show the area that you want to view.

3. To close full screen mode, press Esc.

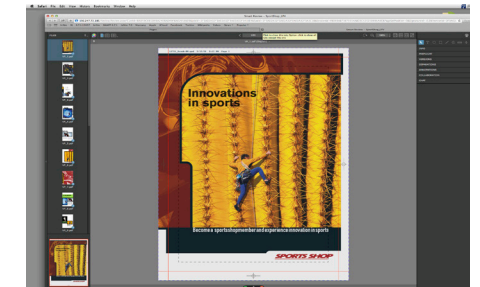
Approve or Reject the Page

1. Click **Approve Page** or **Reject Page**.



2. Select the **Approve Color** or **Reject Color**, type a comment (optional), and click **OK**.
 - (For InSite Prepress Portal 9.1) If you are requested to approve the color and the page content, you can select **Approve Color + Content** to approve the color and the contents at once.
 - If **Approve Color** or **Reject Color** is not available, see the Troubleshooting section below.

3. Close the Smart Review tab.



Troubleshooting

If your monitor is not properly calibrated, you cannot approve pages for color. Recalibrate the monitor and repeat the review and approval process.
