








# Viewing pages in Single View or Spread View mode

You can view a single file in Smart Review in Single View or you can view two files at a time in Spread View.

**Note:** You cannot view rotated files in Spread View.

View pages in any of the following ways:

To	Do this
View a single file	Click <b>Single View</b>  . (This is the default mode.)
View two files at a time	Click <b>Spread View</b>  .
Change the file that is displayed in Single View mode	Perform one of the following actions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In the <b>Files</b> pane, click the name or thumbnail of the file that you want to display.</li><li>• Click <b>Previous Page</b>  or <b>Next Page</b> .</li><li>• In the <b>pages</b> box , type the number of the file that you want to display.</li></ul>
Change the files that are displayed in Spread View mode	Perform one of the following actions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Click <b>Previous Page</b>  to display the files (in Reader Spread mode) before the ones currently displayed, or click <b>Next Page</b>  to display the files after the ones currently displayed.</li><li>• In the <b>Files</b> pane, right-click (Ctrl+click on a Mac computer) the file that you want to <b>Assign to Left or Right View</b> in your spread view.</li></ul>
