

Obtaining a license

InSite Creative Workflow 7.0 specific license keys (TwAm and TwAm Processor) are required in order to upgrade your InSite Creative Workflow system to InSite Creative Workflow 7.0.

If you have a support plan that entitles you to the InSite upgrade at no additional cost, you can obtain an InSite Creative Workflow 7.0 license using the Kodak Product Registration and License Activation System (PLAS).

If you already have a Partner Place account, log on to Partner Place at <https://partnerplace.kodak.com/>.

1. Navigate to Service & Support > Product Registration and License Activation System > View registered products.
2. Select your site, select the InSite product you want to upgrade, and click **Continue**.
3. Click **Apply version upgrade**.
Your new license keys appears.
4. Click **Download the main key** to download the TwAm key in a .txt file, and click **Download the companion key** to download the TwAm Processor key in a .txt file.

If you do not have a Partner Place account, but you have a support plan that entitles you to the InSite upgrade, you can register as a Partner Place user at <https://partnerplace.kodak.com/>. Once you have a Partner Place account, follow the above steps to obtain an InSite Creative Workflow 7.0 license. Alternatively, you can go directly to <https://ecentral.kodak.com/productregistration/> and click **View registered products**. You can then register for PLAS only. This level of registration will enable you to use the PLAS tool to obtain an InSite Creative Workflow 7.0 license but will not enable you to access the rest of Partner Place.

If your support plan does not entitle you to the InSite upgrade, contact your sales representative.

WARNING: Do not proceed with the installation process of the InSite Creative Workflow 7.0 upgrade until you obtain your license key. Once upgraded, InSite Creative Workflow will not operate unless a 7.0 license key is installed.
