Trapping rich blacks

For detailed information about trapping rich blacks, see Trapping black ink.

At the end of this exercise, you should be able to use the **Treat As Black** ink option to apply stayaway traps for rich black graphics.

Note: We recommend that you print this procedure, and follow the steps using the opened drawing file:

- 1. Open RichBlack.pdf.
 - This is a logo that has been colored 40 percent cyan and 100 percent black.
- 2. Start PDF Trap Editor.
- 3. On the Properties Editor toolbar, click the **Trap Page** button.
- 4. Select the Inks dialog box.
- 5. Find the black colorant, and make sure that the **Treat as Black** check box is selected. There's usually no need to clear it.
- 6. Click **Trap Page**.
 - The PDF Trap Editor now traps the page, creating a stayaway trap for the rich black logo.
- 7. Close RichBlack.pdf without saving.
