Review questions: Create Automatically Sized Substrates

- 1. Give an example of when you would want Pandora to automatically create substrate sizes.
 - You may receive a die from a die maker, and want to reduce wasted paper by using the size of the die to determine the size of the substrate.
- 2. Where do you specify the default settings for automatically creating substrates when adding job elements to the layout?
 - In the Preferences dialog box on the **Substrate** tab.
- 3. What job elements are used to create automatically sized substrates?
 - Die, plate, film, or Step and Repeat.
- 4. What is the purpose of the **Always create substrate with these default settings** check box in the Preferences dialog box?
 - Selecting the **Always create substrate with these default settings** check box always creates substrates based on your settings in the Preferences dialog box.

Clearing the **Always create substrate with these default settings** check box prompts you to specify the size of the margins when adding the die, plate, film, or Step and Repeat to the job.
