

# The View menu in the Press Runs view

The **View** menu lets you control the details that you see in the workspace. You can toggle these menu items between showing and hiding the specified items.

<b>Show Dimensions</b>	Displays the layout dimensions, including distances between page edges or centers (depending on settings in the Preferences dialog box) and between adjacent pages and press sheet edges. Select a layout element to edit its text boxes.
<b>Show Page Previews</b>	Displays a preview of all page content
<b>Show Page Sizes</b>	Displays the width and height of the selected page, page group, mark, stock, or media
<b>Show Trim Boxes</b>	Displays a dark blue box that indicates the page trim size
<b>Show Bleed Boxes</b>	Displays a red box that shows the page bleed margins
<b>Show File Page Numbers</b>	Displays the input file's page number on each page
<b>Show File Names</b>	Displays the input file name on each page. If <b>Show File Page Numbers</b> is also selected, the page number is added to the file name.
<b>Show Template Page Numbers</b>	Displays the page numbers at the center of each page
<b>Show Marks, Show Pages</b>	Displays or hides the pages or marks. For example, turning off the display of pages makes it easier to check or select marks.
<b>Show Tiles</b>	Displays the tiles and tile marks, if applicable
<b>Show Group Count</b>	Displays the number of pages in each ganged or step-and-repeat page group
<b>Show Folio</b>	Displays the folio that you assigned in the <b>Pages List</b>
