File menu in Rule Builder

Use the menu items in the **File** menu to open, save, print, and hot swap rule sets.

New Rule Set

Opens Rule Builder so that you can create a rule set

Open

Displays the Open Rule Set dialog box where you can navigate through rule set groups and select a rule set to open.

If the rule set is enabled or read-only, a dialog box appears, asking you to choose whether to open a copy of the rule set or open the rule set in read-only mode. You cannot change a rule set that is enabled or read-only.

Close

Closes the current Rule Builder window. If the rule set is not saved, you are prompted to save it.

Save

Saves the current rule set.

If the rule set has not been saved before, it opens the Save As dialog box, where you give the rule set a name and locate it in a group.

Not available if the rule set has not been changed.

Save As

Opens the Save As dialog box where you can save the rule set with a different name or in a different group

Print Preview

Enables you to see how the rule set will appear when you print it.

Opens the Page Setup dialog box, where you specify:

- Paper size and source
- Orientation
- Margins
- Printer name and the printer-specific settings, including scaling

When you click **OK**, the rule set appears in the Print Preview window, where you can change the view size and print the rule set.

Print

Prints the rule set after opening the Page Setup dialog box, where you specify:

- Paper size and source
- Orientation
- Margins
- Printer name and the printer-specific settings, including scaling

Close & Hot Swap

When you determine the reason for a problem in a rule set using Rule Debugger, from Rule Debugger you can open the rule set in Rule Builder and edit the rule set to fix the problem. You can then select **Close & Hot Swap** to replace the original rule set with the new rule set. When you select this menu item, the Hot Swap Rule Set dialog box opens, prompting you to replace the rule set in all jobs or in specific jobs and to specify a name for the new rule set. When the hot swap is completed, the original rule set is renamed and the rule set's execution history is retained.

Close Window

Closes the current window, but does not quit Workshop
