- 1. From the File menu, select Save.
- 2. Navigate to the location where you want to save the mark.
- 3. In the **File name** box, type a name for the mark.
- 4. From the **Save as type** list, select **Adobe PDF (\*PDF)**.
- 5. Click Save.

- 6. From the left pane, select **General** and configure these settings:
  - a. For **Compatibility**, save the file as Acrobat 8 version.
  - b. Under **Options**, clear all the check boxes.
