Using variable marks in an Imposition Plan

- 1. In Preps, create a template.
- 2. Add variable marks to the template.

Note: In Preps, use the \$[xxxxx] variable marks. When you add variable marks to the template, leave enough space between each variable mark to ensure that the populated variable marks do not overlap each other.

- 3. Use the template in a Preps job.
- 4. Print the job to an Adobe job ticket or JDF.
- 5. Submit the imposition plan: that is, the PJTF or JDF.
- 6. When the system applies a process template to the imposition plan, the system automatically populates the variable marks.
