Installing fonts

The system supports both Western and Asian fonts, also known as CJK (Chinese, Japanese, Korean) fonts.

Fonts are supplied in one of two file types:

- Protected (PostScript fonts): Refined in Prinergy Evo (The location of the PostScript fonts is specified in the file itself.)
- Unprotected (data fonts): Set in a predefined location (no refine is necessary)

Note: It is a best practice to use PostScript files rather than data files. The setup is easier and faster and there is less room for error.
