



Registration Error Simulation

You can simulate registration errors that may occur during printing to evaluate whether you have sufficient trap on objects. When you use **Simulation**, areas without sufficient trap will display as white gaps, which can then be corrected by modifying the trap width.

1. From the right-side **Options** menu of **Preview**, select (Misregistration) **Simulation**



2. Set an **Error Value** by typing a value or dragging the slider. Up to three decimal places can be entered.




3. Click **Simulate Again**. The right side shows the result of misregistration.

4. Adjust the width of the trap if necessary, and simulate the preview again. You can toggle displaying and hiding the trap layer.
