
Node Optimization

Use the **Node Optimization** Tool to remove unnecessary path nodes without affecting the original path appearance. Use this tool to optimize the paths of the trapping area made by Prinergy.

- 1. Select the path you want to work with.
- 2. In the Illustrator menu bar, from the **Window** menu, select **Prinergy Tools > Tool > Node Optimization**.


The Node Optimization dialog box appears.



3. Set the optimization **Precision**, including its unit of measure, and click **OK**. If you don't change the precision unit, Node Optimization will use the document's default unit of measure.

Note: The larger the precision value, the more nodes will be optimized, but path deformation might occur during path simulation.
