

New Features in Prinergy Workflow 9.0.1

Digital

- 31 digital connectivity licenses
 - bonus "Digital Press Connections" licenses are now available to all Prinergy 9.x licenses. The additional licenses will be available after your next license retrieval (manual or automatic).
- Nexpress Bi-Directional JDF Connectivity - Nexpress device should be added via Setup. Legacy method of Adding Connection in Prinergy Administrator is no longer supported in Prinergy 9.0.1 and above.
- Nexpress JDF support with Prinergy Track
- Minimum supported Nexpress DFE is version 22

Active Directory Support

- When the Prinergy server is part of an Active Directory Domain, you can now login to Workshop with DomainName\UserName
 - When logging into Workshop with: DomainName\UserName. The User Name column in Job History will now display as DomainName\UserName. This may affect any RBA, Automation or reports you have based on this column. Update your rules accordingly.
- You can setup Prinergy Administrator User Rights to be unique for users within various Active Directory groups
- Supports domain users within Prinergy Administrator > User Rights
- Supports local and domain groups within Prinergy Administrator > User Rights
- Added User Right to control Workshop login

Best Practice:

Make sure the Araxi service and Prinergy App Pools are configured to logon with a Domain account.

- See the 9.0.1 known limitations section for an issue, where user favourites will be lost
- See the Prinergy System Administrator Guide, for information on adding the Prinergy Primary to a domain
- Logging into Workshop with the '@' Domain character (i.e DomainName@UserName) is not supported
