System administration overview

This section gives you an overview of the Kodak Prinergy workflow management system, with a closer focus on required administrative tasks. The main administrative tasks include:

- Helping to complete the onsite integration of the Prinergy system. (This is done with the Kodak start-up assistance (SUA) representative.)
- Performing additional installation setup
- Performing ongoing system configuration
- Performing general maintenance
- Troubleshooting problems
- Performing software updates

Who should read this overview?

Those who are responsible for the server-client system that supports Prinergy prepress workflow management, usually system administrators.

What else do you need for system administration?

As the system administrator for a new Prinergy system:

- You will have completed Windows Administration training.
- You must have a Prinergy system onsite that is being installed or has been installed and tested by a Kodak service representative.
