

Printing to a PostScript file from desktop software

To print reliable PostScript files for submission to Prinergy Evo, it is a best practice to use the **Prinergy Refiner PPD**, which you installed when you installed your Prinergy Evo Client software.

If you are printing to PostScript from Macintosh or Windows desktop software, it is a best practice to set up your print driver (for example, AdobePS or LaserWriter) with the **Prinergy Refiner PPD** as the printer model or printer description.

If you do not have a Refine to PDF license, you must submit PDF files to the system for output to proof, film, or plate.

1. From your desktop application, print to a PostScript file.
It is a best practice to use the **Prinergy Refiner PPD** as the printer model or printer description when printing to a PostScript file.
2. In Distiller software, create a job options file.
3. In Distiller software, distill the PostScript file to PDF using the job options file.
