

Exporting a user-defined color library

You can export user-defined libraries that can be imported by Prinergy software and Prinergy Evo.

1. Start the Prinergy Evo client.
2. From the **Configure** menu in the Process Viewer, select the **Color Definitions**.
3. In the Color Database Editor dialog box, from the **Color Libraries** list, select a user-defined library that you want to export.
4. Click **Export**.
5. In the Export Color Library dialog box, select a location for the user-defined library you want to export.
6. On a Windows-based computer, in the **File name** box, type a name for the user library and click **Export**. On a Macintosh computer, in the **Save as** box, type a name for the user library and click **Export**.

The system exports a Prinergy-based color library file.
