

Changing the password of the Araxi service in a domain

If you are in a Windows domain and you want to change the password of the Araxi service account, make the change on the domain controller.

1. On a domain controller, log on as a domain administrator.
2. Change the password:
 - a. From the **Start** menu, select **Programs > Administrative Tools > Active Directory Users and Computers**.
 - b. On the **Tree** tab, click the domain node to expand the tree.
 - c. Select the folder that contains the Araxi service account.
The default account is called **Araxi**.
If you are not using folders to organize your accounts, the Araxi service account is typically under **Users**.
 - d. Right-click the Araxi service account, and select **Reset Password**.
 - e. In the **Password** and **Confirm Password** boxes, type a password
 - f. Clear the **User must change password at next logon** check box, and click **OK**.

Please note you need to perform this change on local ARAXI accounts or any other computer for any service using the Domain ARAXI account within your organization.
