

Identifying Process IDs

Identify a Process ID (PID) so that you can troubleshoot, end a process, trace the daemon state, check memory usage, and so on.

Find the process ID number in one of the following locations:

- In the **Process** pane, under the **Application** column.
The name of the process is followed by the process ID number—for example, **Spool Daemon (418)**.
- In Windows Task Manager, under the **PID** column
