

# Printing to a PostScript file from QuarkXPress 7 and 8

After downloading the refiner and setting up a PS printer, use this procedure to print a PostScript file from QuarkXPress 7 or 8.

1. In the QuarkXPress software, open the document and click **File > Print**.
2. Click **Printer**, and click **OK** in the message dialog box.
3. In the Print dialog box, click **PDF**, and select **Save PDF as PostScript**.
4. In the Save dialog box, define the desired location and file name, and click **Save**.
5. In the Print dialog box, on the **Device** tab, in the **PPD** box, select **Prinergy Refiner**.
6. On the **Color** tab, in the **Mode** box, select **Composite**. In the **Setup** box, select **As is**.  
Select the appropriate options for OPI, marks, and other aspects. See [Relevant options for printing to PostScript for Prinergy](#).
7. Click **Print**.
