

Assign Page to Page Set Position dialog box

Page Set

Displays the name of the page set to which you are assigning the selected pages.

Position

Use this list to select the page positions to which you want to assign the selected pages. Options are:

- **Position**
- **Odd Position**
- **Even Position**
- **Unassigned Position**

Starting at

Displays the page number at which you want to start the range of page assignments. You can type in this box to change the starting page number.

Range

Use this box instead of the **Position** list when you want to manually specify the page positions to which the selected pages (as listed in the **Page** column) will be assigned. To assign a single page to multiple positions, use brackets in the **Range** box. For example, typing (1, 3, 5) in the **Range** box assigns the selected single page to positions 1, 3, and 5. To assign multiple pages to nonconsecutive positions, don't use brackets in the **Range** box. For example, typing 1, 3, 5 in the **Range** box assigns the selected three pages to positions 1, 3, and 5.

Position

Displays the page position to which the page will be assigned based on the position or range that you specified.

Page

The name of the page that will be assigned to the page position. Pages are listed in the order in which you selected them.
