

Selecting by marquee

Marquee selection allows you to more easily select several items at a time. The list of selected items appears in the Properties Editor window arranged by type and color.

1. To select several items at a time, hold the mouse button and drag a selection rectangle (a marquee) completely around the items you want.
An object fully inside the marquee will be selected.
A selected item shows highlighted with the color you specified in the Adobe Acrobat Preferences menu. An object is also outlined and overlaid with a pattern of bright dots.
2. To add selections to the list, hold down Shift, and draw a marquee around the items to be added.
3. To remove selected objects from a selection list at any time, hold down Shift, and draw a marquee completely around the objects you want to drop from the list. Any selected objects inside the marquee are dropped from the list.
4. Repeat the steps until you are satisfied with your selection list.

Tip: You can select all objects by drawing a marquee around the entire page.
