

Screening an entire page

You can screen a page using the same screen set for all objects. This becomes the default screen.

1. In the Acrobat window, right-click to display the context selection menu.
2. Select **Deselect all** if any objects or groups are already selected.
The Properties Editor shows the default screen for the page.
3. In the Properties Editor, in the **Screen** list, select the screen instance you want to apply to the entire page.
4. (Optional) In the **Calibration Curve** list, select the calibration curve you want to apply.
5. (Optional) Click a colorant's screen angle and select an angle to apply.
6. Click **Apply**.

When you click **Apply**, the screen instance, calibration curve, and colorant angles shown in the Properties Editor are applied to the entire page as the new Default Screen except to those objects that already have another screen applied, including DotShop and unknown screens.

Tip: If the page has no items selected, you can click in the page, and select and apply screening.
