

Switching layers on and off

When the merge file first opens, only the **Output** layer and its sublayers are displayed by default.

- Switch layers on and off by clicking the eye  icon next to each layer. A layer with an eye next to it is displayed; a layer with no eye is hidden. Note that only one main layer (**Input <originalfile>.pdf**, **Input <revisedfile>.pdf**, **Output**, or **Discarded**) can be displayed at one time, although within the **Output** layer or the **Discarded** layer you can display multiple sublayers at once.
Note: Layers whose names appear in bold contain content. Layers whose names are not bold are empty.
Note: If you compare two files with the same file name, the **Layers** tab displays a date and time next to each file as a way to tell the two files apart.
