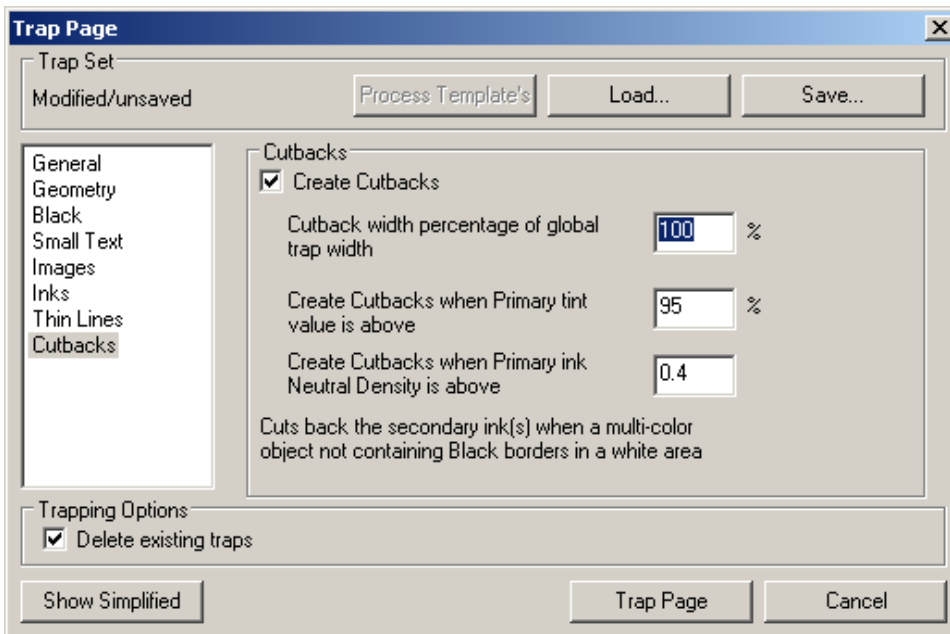


Setting traps with cutbacks

Select to create a trap where multi-colored objects border with white areas of the page. This prevents mis-registration artifacts from being visible along white edges and helps keep knockout (reversed) text from filling in.

1. In PDF Trap Editor, select the Detailed view of the Trap Page or Trap Selection dialog box.
2. Click the **Cutbacks** tab.
3. Select the **Create Cutbacks** check box.
4. In the **Cutback width percentage of global trap width** box, enter the relative width of the global trap that should be taken up by the cutbacks.
5. In the **Create cutbacks when primary tint value is above** box, enter the minimum primary tint value at which cutbacks should be created.
6. In the **Create cutbacks when primary ink neutral density is above** box, enter the minimum neutral density value that the primary ink should be above when cutbacks are created.
