

Setting measurement preferences

- In Mac OS, from the **Prinergy VPS** menu, select **Preferences**, and click the **Measurement** tab.
- In Windows, from the **Edit** menu, select Preferences, and click the **Measurement** tab.

Setting	Description
Linear Units	Set the units in which you want measurements to be displayed in the Measurement palette: points, picas, inches, millimeters, or centimeters.
Linear Precision	Set the slider to indicate the number of digits that you want after the decimal point for distance measurements, from 0 to 6. The left-hand number in the Sample at the bottom of the Measurement tab will show the results of your Linear Precision selection. In the sample below, it is four digits. 123.1235 +123.12°
Angular Precision	Set the slider to indicate the number of digits after the decimal point for angle measurements, from 0 to 6. The right-hand number in the sample at the bottom of the Measurement tab will show the results of your Angular Precision selection. In the sample above, it is two digits.
