

Starting processes

One of the most common tasks in Workshop is starting processes. Any *element* can undergo some sort of processing. For example, you refine input files, generate proofs, make film or plates, and archive job files.

In general, you start a process by selecting the elements to be processed, and then selecting the desired process template. For example, you drag an input file to a refine process template, or drag an imposition to an imposition proof process.

The **Process Templates** pane also includes workflow templates. If you use rules-based automation, the **Process Templates** pane also displays rule sets that have been enabled on the job.
