<i>Activity 1: Getting started</i> Demonstrates how to copy supplied practice files to an accessible location and create a temporary job group in Job Finder.	5-10
<i>Activity 2: Build and use an RBA job rule</i> Introduces Rule Set Manager and Rule Builder, and demonstrates how to build and use a basic RBA job rule. This activity also demonstrates how to copy and edit an existing rule set.	15-20
<i>Activity 3: Use RBA to send e-mail</i> Provides further experience using RBA and demonstrates how to use notification messaging using e-mail. This activity also demonstrates alternate ways that RBA actions can be activated.	15-20
<i>Activity 4: Use an RBA manual trigger</i> Demonstrates how to trigger an RBA rule from Job Manager. This activity also demonstrates how to export and import an RBA rule set.	15-20
<i>Activity 5: Use an RBA hot folder trigger</i> Demonstrates how to trigger an RBA rule using a hot folder. This activity also demonstrates how to embed PDF preflight processes as part of the job rule.	15-20
<i>Activity 6: Create a system rule set</i> Provides experience creating and using an RBA system rule. A system rule can be accessed by any job in a Prinergy system.	15-20
<i>Activity 7: Create an RBA sample workflow</i> Represents a sample workflow that can refine, impose, and generate output. The main objective of the activity is to demonstrate how multiple events and actions can be chained together to create an automated workflow.	20-30
