

# Rerefining PDF pages with spot color mappings

1. See [Creating a refine to PDF process template](#).
2. In the **Spot Color Handling** section, **Source of Color Recipes** area, in the **User Library** list, select the color library that contains the correct spot colors.
3. See [Customizing the template palette](#), attaching the Refine to PDF process template you created in step 1.
4. Drag and drop the input PDF files onto the Template Palette.  
**Important:** The Prinergy Evo server computer must have read, write, and modify privileges on the folder from which you submit input files to Prinergy Evo. Kodak recommends that your input files reside on the Prinergy Evo server computer and you mount them from your Prinergy Evo client computer.
5. In the **Process Start** dialog box, click **Settings**.
6. See [Manually mapping colors](#).
7. Click **OK**.
8. Using the **Priority** slider, select a queuing priority for the refine process.
9. Click **OK** to start the refine to PDF process.
