
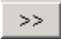


# Selecting Kodak proofers

Prinerger Evo software detects all of the Kodak proofers on the network. Before you can use a proofer, add it in the Select Kodak Proofers dialog box. When you have successfully added a proofer, it appears in the output from PDF, output from imposition, and output from PostScript process templates.

To do this	Do this
Add a Kodak proofer	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. In the Prinerger Evo Administrator, click the <b>Tools</b> tab.</li><li>2. Click <b>Kodak Proofers</b>.</li><li>3. In the Select Kodak Proofers dialog box, select one or more proofers in the <b>Visible Kodak Proofers</b> list and click  to use the proofers. To select all of the proofers in the <b>Visible Kodak Proofers</b> list, click . If the name of the proofer that you want does not appear in the <b>Visible Kodak Proofers</b> list (this may happen if the proofer is in a different subnet than the Prinerger Evo Administrator), you can add its name by clicking <b>Use</b>. <b>Note:</b> When manually adding the name of a proofer, ensure you type its name correctly. Otherwise, the server will not correctly appear in the Process Template Editor.</li><li>4. Click <b>OK</b>. <b>Important:</b> Before the proofers are available to use, restart the Prinerger Evo Administrator by clicking <b>Restart</b> on the <b>System</b> tab. The restart process may take a few minutes.</li><li>5. To double-check that the server has been successfully added, open the Process Template Editor in Prinerger Evo software and complete the following steps:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Open an output from PDF process template.</li><li>b. From the <b>Output To</b> list, select <b>Kodak Proofers</b>.</li><li>c. In the <b>Device</b> section, ensure that the proofers you just added appear in the <b>Proofer Name</b> list.</li></ol></li></ol>
Remove a Kodak proofer	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. In the Prinerger Evo Administrator, click the <b>Tools</b> tab.</li><li>2. Click <b>Kodak Proofers</b>.</li><li>3. In the Select Kodak Proofers dialog box, select one or more proofers in the <b>Kodak Proofers to Use</b> list and click <b>Remove</b>.</li><li>4. Click <b>OK</b>. <b>Important:</b> After the proofers are removed, restart the Prinerger Evo Administrator by clicking <b>Restart</b> on the <b>System</b> tab. The restart process may take a few minutes.</li></ol>
