Workstations

The Matchprint Inkjet proofing solution purchased determines the type of workstation that will run the server component of Kodak Proofing Software. The use of client workstations is optional. Brief descriptions follow—see also the applicable specifications.

Matchprint Inkjet proofer controller

Also known as KPS controller, proofer controller, or server.

For systems purchased directly from Kodak, the currently-shipping workstation is a businessclass Dell OptiPlex (Windows 10), configured for reliability, high performance, and efficient use of disk space.

Client workstations, as needed

Customers are responsible for providing the client workstations. A proofer client workstation can be used to submit files and access the Controller software for one or more MPI proofers. (Other computers in the network can also be used for basic file submission via hot folders.)
